

A family owned 60 acre farm since 2006, South Pond is on the Oak Ridges Moraine in the traditional territory of the Anishinaabe Mississauga. The house and barn were built in 1865. Restoration of the barn and buildings began in 2009. The land has been regenerated and turned into gardens for vegetables, flowers and each year we work to add more native species to the land.

South Pond is a special event venue and is a favourite for hosting authentic barn weddings, private events and group experiences. Throughout the year we hold a variety of instructional craft and cooking workshops, as well as delicious farm-to-table lunch and dinner social gatherings.

Enjoy a self guided tour of the farm. Please participate in seasonal activities, visit our animals, the bakery and shop and have lunch when it's available.




You are welcome to walk the adjoining Ballyduff Trails on the McKim-Garsonnin property that wind through 260 acres protected by the Kawartha Land Trust.
